ADDENDA TO THE PARTICULAR RULES

INTRODUCTION

This document holds an Addenda to the **Particular Rules** to follow in the Interceltic Underwater Photography Competition, within the 2009 INTERCELTIC GAMES, and it must be regarded as an extension to the **General Rules** V1.0EN, of 17/7/2009 and to the **Particular Rules** V1.0EN, of 29/7/2009.

This Addenda introduces important modifications to the General Rules, mainly imposed by the logistic conditions at the Berlenga Island, where the competition dives will take place. Such conditions being further aggravated because the competition happens during the peak of the holiday season.

2. PARTICULAR RULES

2.6. Changes to article 1.6.2.2 of the General Rules

New redaction of this article:

1.6.2.2. One or two cards may be used by camera and by competition day. Accordingly, if the competitor uses one card for each competition dive, he must have two cards for each camera. If the competitor uses the same card for the two competition dives of the day, he only must have one card per camera.

2.7. Changes to article 1.6.2.4 of the General Rules

New redaction of this article:

1.6.2.4. **The first photo on each card must contain the image of the photographer or his assistant, with the label supplied by the Organization** That image is named IIS (Series Start Image). **Any infraction to the present rule will imply the elimination of the card(s) under question.**

If the competitor uses only one card per competition day, he must do a new IIS before the beginning of the second competition dive of the day.

2.8. Elimination of article 1.6.2.5 of the General Rules

With the elimination of this article, no limits remain as to the number of images that can be taken in each competition period.

2.9. Changes to article 1.6.2.7 of the General Rules

New redaction of this article:

1.6.2.7. If the competitor uses one card per camera for each competition period, in between the two competition periods of a competition day, i.e., since the moment when the card(s) used in the first competition period of the day were delivered to the Referee, and until the moment where the in-camera formatting of the card(s) for the second competition period of the day takes place, the competitors are free to handle their cameras as they please.

If the competitor uses a single card per camera for the two competition periods of the day, he must not handle his camera(s) during the time in between the two periods, except to do the IIS corresponding to the second period, always in the presence of a Referee.

2.10. Elimination of article 1.6.2.8 of the General Rules

This article is eliminated, given the absence of conditions at Berlenga to comply with it.
